

# Overview of Eco-Forum Global

As an independent, not-for-profit foundation, Eco-Forum Global (EFG) is China's primary national platform to foster sustainable development and build eco-civilization. EFG aims at promoting eco-civilization by convening global leaders from government, business, academia, media and civil society. EFG serves as 1) a bridge for inter-governmental and cross-industry cooperation; 2)a window to showcase best practices in building sustainable industries and green cities; 3) a conduit to shape global, regional and industrial agenda in green transformation.

Despite its non-governmental and non-profit nature, the inception of EFG signifies the joint efforts of Chinese National Development and Reform Commission, National Committee on Population, Resources and Environment of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC), Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Industry and Information Technology, Ministry of Environmental Protection, Ministry of Housing and Rural-Urban Development, Ministry of Commerce, State Forestry Administration, Chinese Academy of Science, Chinese Academy of Engineering, China Association of Mayors and Peking University, as well as UN agencies and other leading international organizations. The co-founder and Executive Chairman ZHANG Xinsheng is President of the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN, the world's first global environmental organization and the largest professional global conservation network, with Permanent Observer Status at the United Nations General Assembly). He was also Chairman of the Executive Board of UNESCO (2005-2007).

Since its foundation in 2009, EFG has engaged nearly ten thousand top governmental leaders, Nobel Laureates, influential business executives and NGO representatives to address our common challenges and explore effective solutions.



Chinese President XI Jinping and Chinese Prime Minister LI Keqiang have sent their congratulatory letters to EFG's conferences. Chinese Vice President LI Yuanchao and Chinese Deputy Prime Minister ZHANG Gaoli attended EFG's conferences and delivered their speeches. Other speakers include 9 incumbent state leaders and some former state leaders such as former British Prime Minister Tony Blair, former British Deputy Prime Minister John Prescott, former German Chancellor Gerhard Schröder, former President of the European Commission and Italian Prime Minister Romano Prodi, former Australian Prime Minister Kevin Rudd, etc. In 2011 and 2014, Ban Ki-moon, Secretary-General of the United Nations, sent formal letters to EFG, recognizing the importance of EFG's conferences.

At the Rio+20 Summit, EFG organized two successful side events with support and active participation of influential figures including former UN Under-Secretary-General and Secretary-General of the Rio+20 SHA Zukang, former UN Under-Secretary-General and Secretary-General of the 1992 Earth Summit at Rio Maurice Strong, Chairman of IPCC Rajendra Pachauri, Chinese leaders, and some other international celebrities. In July 2012, EFG organized the first international major post-Rio+20 international forum with more than 1000 participants to mobilize the implementation of the outcomes of the Rio+20 Summit.

EFG has been well received by Forum participants for its vision and pragmatic approaches in promoting sustainable development. The activities organized by EFG have been celebrated by over 200 Chinese and leading international media agencies, such as CCTV, People's Daily, Xinhua News Agency, China Daily, CNN and BBC.

EFG was the only Chinese organization of its kind that submitted a voluntary commitment at the Summit.

Upon establishing a close, cooperative relationship with **Switzerland**, a Swiss delegation led by state leaders participated in a series of panels on Sino-Swiss dialogue for two consecutive years. **Ueli MAURER**, President of the Swiss Confederation, attended and addressed the Eco Forum Global Annual Summer Summit 2013. **Hannes GERMANN**, President of the Council of States of Switzerland's Federal Assembly, attended and addressed the Eco Forum Global Annual Summer Summit 2014. During his meeting with President Maurer, President Xi said he is looking forward to more exchanges and closer cooperation between the two countries on eco-civilization construction and development in mountain areas. Switzerland was the first European country who signed a Free Trade Agreement with China, bringing along competitive advantages in green finance, clean technology, low-carbon development, and circular economy.



To introduce **Austria**'s extensive experience in green urbanization and smart city development, EFG and the Austrian government co-organized a sub-forum "Urbanization: Establishing Smart Energy City – Learning from Austria's Experience". **Irene GINER-REICHL**, Austrian Ambassador to the People's Republic of China and to Mongolia, has attended EFG's annual summer summit for three consecutive years, and believes in EFG's role as an international platform of promoting cooperation between Austria and China.







The **UK** has participated in EFG's events actively. At the EFG Annual Summer Summit 2014, **John PRESCOTT**, Former Deputy Prime Minister of the UK, delivered a speech, and the British Embassy co-organized the UK-China Clean Coal Seminar. Moreover, the British Royal Family has expressed interest in cooperating with the Forum.

Featuring distinctive theories and practices in the area of low-carbon urbanization, the Building and Construction Authority of **Singapore** co-organized the "Singapore Experience in Low Carbon Urbanization Forum" at the EFG Annual Summer Summit 2014 to share its experience.

In addition, countries such as **Brazil**, **Korea**, and **Denmark** have expressed their willingness to engage in a partnership with EFG to jointly promote sustainable development and eco-civilization construction.







## OUR ORIGIN



## July 2014

The 6th EFG Annual Summer Summit themed around reforms was successfully convened, where institutional design and path direction of green development were intensely discussed.



### July 2013

The 5th EFG Annual Summer Summit themed "Building Eco-Civilization: Green Transformation and Transition – Green Industry, Green Urbanization and Green Consumption Lead Sustainable Development" was successfully held, attracting over 4,000 people including domestic and international state leaders, entrepreneurs, scholars, and media representatives.



### November 2012

The Eighteenth National Congress of the CPC was held to propose the "Five-in-One" Scheme which raised eco-civilization construction to the national strategic level.



#### 2009

The first EFG Annual Summer Summit was successfully held. It first proposed "green economy" in China.



#### December 1997

The **Kyoto Protocol** was adopted in the UNFCCC COP3,which outlined the greenhouse gas emissions reduction obligation for Annex I countries.



## 1988

Guizhou Provincial leaders made efforts to explore a development way leading to the harmony between human and nature, as well as social and economic sustainability, becoming the first to propose eco-construction.



#### 1972

The Limits to Growth is a book modeling the consequences of a rapidly growing world population and finite resource supplies, commissioned by the Club of Rome.



### 1962

*Silent Spring* written by Rachel Carson was published and has become widely credited with helping launch the first environmental movement in human history.

#### October 2014

The forum "Green Finance Facilitating Smart New-Type Urbanization" was organized and convened by EFG in Hangzhou.

#### November 2013

The Third Plenary Session of the Eighteenth CPC Central Committee announced to intensify reforms of ecocivilization system and accelerate ecocivilization construction; the National Deepening Reform Leadership Team set up its first specialist group - Economic and Eco-Civilization Institutional Reform Specialist Group, indicating the inseparable relationship between eco-civilization construction and economic development as well as the great opportunity for green transformation.

## June 2012

On the occasion of the UNCSD-Rio+20 Summit, EFG successfully convened two side events at the Rio+20 Conference Center in Brazil, becoming the only Chinese organization of its kind that submitted a **voluntary commitment** to the Summit.

### 2007

Chinese Communist Party's Seventeenth National People's Congress first officially proposed the construction of **ecological civilizion**.

#### 1992

Agenda 21, was adopted at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) held in Rio de Janerio, June 1992.

#### 1980

The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) first articulately introduced and defined the notion of sustainable development in the history of mankind

#### June 1972

The world's first convention on environmental protection was convened in Stockholm.
